

## **RULE G**

### **SPECIAL RULES**

#### **(1) Emergency Telephone Numbers**

When counsel urgently needs action or advice and cannot wait for normal business hours, counsel may use these emergency telephone numbers to call the person on duty: (787) 766-6000 (United States Marshal); (787) 772-3000 (Clerk of Court).

#### **(2) Assignment of Actions**

If the judge to whom a case under the Local Admiralty Rules has been assigned is not readily available, any matter under the Local Admiralty Rules may be presented to any other judge in the district without reassigning the case.

#### **(3) Newspapers for Publishing Notices**

Every notice required to be published under the Local Admiralty Rules or any rules or statutes applying to admiralty and maritime proceedings shall be published in the following newspapers of general circulation in the District: The San Juan Star, "El Nuevo Día," and "El Vocero de Puerto Rico."

#### **(4) Use of State Procedures**

When the plaintiff invokes a state procedure in order to attach or garnish under Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(e), the process of attachment or garnishment shall so state.
