7 This court is authorized to accept payment of fees through  
8 electronic credit/debit card payment system established by the United  
9 States Department of Treasury, known as Pay.gov ([https://www.  
10 pay.gov](https://www.pay.gov)). The court will accept major credit cards and debit cards  
11 that **do not require a PIN number.**

12 Effective March 4, 2008, payment of fees through the Pay.gov  
13 electronic credit/debit card payment system shall be required of all  
14 registered users of the court's CM/ECF system.

15 Upon presentation of a document for filing electronically,  
16 registered users of CM/ECF shall be directed to the Pay.gov site and  
17 shall pay the filing fee by use of the Pay.gov internet credit/debit  
18 card payment system.

19 The period starting on March 4, 2008, and ending on June 3,  
20 2008, will be considered a transition period. During this transition  
21 period, filers will have three options for the payment of fees,  
22 opening cases, and filing civil complaints:

- 23 1. A filer may open a civil case, pay the filing fee, and file  
24 the complaint electronically using CM/ECF and Pay.gov.
