Hours of Operation in the Aftermath of Hurricane María

SAN JUAN (October 3, 2017) -- Chief Judge Aida M. Delgado-Colón announced today that the Clerk's Office for the United States District Court for the District of Puerto Rico has resumed **internal** operations under a provisional schedule of 9:00 a.m. to Noon, and 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.

This provisional schedule is effective at both, the main Clerk's Office at the Federico Degetau Federal Building in Hato Rey, and its annex at the José V. Toledo Federal Building in Old San Juan, from October 3, 2017 until October 13, 2017. This provisional schedule will be effective from October 3, 2017 until October 13, 2017, at both locations.

The Federico Degetau Federal Building in Hato Rey and the José V. Toledo Federal Building in Old San Juan will **open to the public** on Tuesday, October 10, 2017. This provisional schedule will remain in place from Tuesday, October 10, 2017 through Friday, October 13, 2017. During this period, the cashier window at the Federico Degetau Federal Building will observe a provisional schedule of 9:00 a.m. to 11:45 a.m., and 1:00 p.m. to 2:45 p.m.

Court operations and services to the public will fully resume as normal on Monday, October 16, 2017, at which time facilities at the Clemente Ruiz Nazario U.S. Courthouse and Federico Degetau Federal Building in Hato Rey, and the José V. Toledo Federal Building in Old San Juan will open to the public, **observing regular working hours**.

The Clerk's Office at both locations observes regular working hours of 8:30 a.m., to Noon, and 1:00 p.m. to 4:45 p.m. The cashier window at the Clerk's Office at the Federico Degetau Federal Building is open to the public from 8:30 a.m. to 11:45 a.m., and from 1:00 p.m. to 4:45 p.m.
