

**Franco L. Pérez-Redondo** is an Assistant Federal Public Defender and Chief of the Appellate Division at the Federal Public Defender's Office for the District of Puerto Rico. Since 2016, he has provided direct representation to indigent clients in federal trials, appeals, and post-conviction proceedings, including habeas litigation on behalf of Puerto Rico state prisoners seeking relief in federal court.
