Proposed Amendment to Local Rule 5(g)

All documents not in the English Language which are presented or filed, whether as evidence or otherwise, must be accompanied by a certified translation into English prepared by:

- (a) a certified court interpreter or,
- (b) a translator, certified by the American Translator Association or accredited post-graduate educational institution, or,
- (c) a translator who has approved Phase I (written legal translation) of the Federal Court Interpreters Certification Examination.
