Due to the imminent passage of Hurricane Maria, the United States District Court for the District of Puerto Rico, including all its dependencies, will close today, September 18, 2017, at 2:30PM, and remain closed Tuesday, September 19, Wednesday, September 20 and Thursday, September 21, 2017. CM/ECF and eVoucher system services will remain available for counsel.

The Court will make an assessment by the afternoon of Thursday, September 21, 2017, and determine whether to resume operations on Friday, September 22, 2017.
