**Increase in Daily Attendance Fee for Jurors**

We are pleased to announce that effective May 7, 2018, the daily attendance fee for all petit and grand jurors serving in the federal courts is \$50.00 instead of \$40.00. As per Standing Order signed September 19, 2007 in Misc. No. 07-190, Docket No. 1, grand jurors serving in this District will be paid an additional \$10.00 for each day of service in excess of 45 days. The discretionary increase, of as much as \$10.00 per day for petit jurors serving more than 10 days, remains unchanged.

This increase was included in the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2018, P.L. 115-141, signed into law by the President on March 23, 2018. This is the first increase in the daily juror attendance fee since 1990 despite previous efforts by the Judicial Conference and the Administrative Office of the United States Courts.
