DISTRICT COURT OPERATIONS TO CLOSE ON WEDNESDAY AUGUST 28, 2019
DUE TO THE IMMINENT PASSING OF TROPICAL STORM DORIAN

Chief Judge Gustavo A. Gelpi, and the Chairperson of the Facilities Security Committee, District Judge Aida M. Delgado-Colón, inform that, due to a change in the trajectory of Tropical Storm Dorian, and in order to ensure the safety of all court personnel and public, the Clemente Ruiz-Nazario U.S. Courthouse in Hato Rey and the José V. Toledo U.S. Courthouse in Old San Juan, along with all district court dependencies, will be closed on Wednesday August 28, 2019. District Court operations and services to the public, including all its dependencies, are expected to resume on Thursday August 29, 2019.

The P.O.W.E.R. Act event which was to be held in the Clemente Ruiz Nazario U.S. Courthouse will be rescheduled for a new date to be announced within the next couple of days. All members of the bar and public are encouraged to access the Court's CM/ECF electronic filing system for updated information on scheduled hearings and cases originally scheduled for Wednesday August 28, 2019.
