Court to Close Due to Imminent Passage of Tropical Storm Isaac

Due to the imminent passage of Tropical Storm Isaac, the United States District Court for the District of Puerto Rico, including all its dependencies, will remain closed on Thursday, August 23, 2012. We are expecting to resume normal operations by Friday, August 24, 2012.

The Federico Degetau Federal Building will remain fully operational on August 23-24. CJA panel attorneys are placed on notice that the U.S. Sentencing Commission training scheduled for Friday, August 24, remains on schedule.
