PROCEEDINGS VIA VIDEO TELECONFERENCE BEGINNING MAY 4, 2020**

The United States District Court for the District of Puerto Rico will like to remind members of the bar of the following information on court operations:

1. As stated in [Notice of the Clerk 20-10](#), starting on May 4, 2020, judges of the United States District Court for the District of Puerto Rico will begin to hold certain hearings, conferences and proceedings by Video Teleconference (“VTC”) in civil and criminal cases.
2. As stated in [Notice of the Clerk 20-09](#), and until further notice, the Intake section of the Clerk’s Office for the District of Puerto Rico will be open for business only on Tuesdays and Fridays from 9:00AM to 4:00PM. The rest of the week, Clerk’s Office Intake section will remain closed to reduce the risk of exposure associated with the COVID-19 virus and in protection of the health and well-being of court employees and members of the Bar.
