**AMENDMENT TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE DIRECTIVE
REGARDING AMENDMENT 821**

On November 9, 2023, the District court issued the Administrative Directive Regarding Amendment 821 (the "Administrative Directive"). Pursuant to the Administrative Directive, the Clerk of Court must automatically refer Amendment 821 Motions to a United States Magistrate Judge for initial screening.

The District Court hereby amends the Administrative Directive to designate Magistrate Judge Giselle López-Soler to conduct this initial screening. In the absence or unavailability of Magistrate Judge López-Soler the initial screening will be referred to Magistrate Judge Héctor L. Ramos-Vega.

This Amendment shall enter effect March 9, 2026.
