

STANDING ORDER REGARDING RECORDING DEVICES

While laptop computers and cellular telephones are permitted inside the courtroom, these devices may not be used for visual or audio recording under any circumstances without prior leave from the Court. A party may, however, order a transcript of the proceedings from the Court stenographer, Yvette Richardson. Failure to abide by this *Order* shall constitute contempt of Court. Accordingly, the Court will not hesitate to impose civil and/or criminal penalties on an offending party.
