STANDING ORDER

This Standing Order addresses petitions to modify conditions of bail release filed by criminal defendants. It is hereby **ORDERED** that such petitions shall comply with the following:

1. Criminal defendants requesting modifications of bail release conditions shall consult with the government and the U.S. Probation Officer prior to the filing of such motions. The motion **MUST** inform the Court whether the government and/or the U.S. Probation Office have any objections concerning the request.
2. Requests to modify bail release conditions to attend events or requests to modify conditions on a specific day shall be filed at least seven (7) days prior, absent good cause.
3. Motions to modify bail release conditions that contain any objection shall be referred to the Magistrate Judge that presided over defendant's Bail Hearing. Therefore, all such motions shall be addressed to the appropriate Magistrate Judge.

Failure to comply with the requirements listed above may result in denial of the petition.
