## **GENERAL STANDING ORDER**

Unless otherwise ordered by the presiding judicial officer, any defendant granted pretrial release with a location monitoring condition who is released after the Court's regular hours of operation (8:00am to 5:00pm) will be allowed to report to the U.S. Probation Office the next business day for installation thereof. All other conditions of pretrial release will be in full force and effect immediately upon imposition.

However, the installation of a location monitoring device on a defendant released after regular hours of operation on a Friday or on a weekday followed by a holiday will be made on the same day.

This order is not applicable to pretrial defendants charged with a sex offense.

IT IS SO ORDERED to be effective immediately.
