GENERAL STANDING ORDER OF DISQUALIFICATION

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 455(a), the undersigned disqualify themselves from any proceedings in which Hon. Maite D. Oronoz-Rodríguez, Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Puerto Rico, is sued in her personal or official capacity. Chief Justice Oronoz-Rodríguez is United States District Judge Gina R. Méndez-Miró's spouse.

Judge Méndez-Miró did not participate in the discussion or approval of this Standing Order and is disqualified from any proceedings to which Chief Justice Oronoz-Rodríguez is a party pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 455 (b)(5)(i).

Any proceeding in which Chief Justice Oronoz-Rodríguez is sued in her personal or official capacity will be randomly assigned to a visiting judge or to a judge chosen by the Chief Judge of the United States Court of Appeals for the First Circuit.

This Standing Order is intended to preserve public trust in the integrity and independence of the District of Puerto Rico by avoiding even the appearance of a conflict of interest.
