Changes to the Miscellaneous Fee Schedule

The Judicial Conference approved inflationary increases to the Miscellaneous Fee Schedules. The increases to the items listed under the District Court Miscellaneous Fee Schedule, 28 U.S.C. § 1914, are as follows:

Description of Fee	Current Fee	New Fee
For filing any document that is not related to a pending case or proceeding	\$47.00	\$49.00
Search Fee	\$31.00	\$32.00
Exemplification	\$22.00	\$23.00
For reproduction of an audio recording of a court proceeding	\$31.00	\$32.00
Misdemeanor Appeal	\$38.00	\$39.00
For original admission of attorney to practice, including a certificate of admission	\$181.00	\$188.00
For a duplicate certificate of admission or certificate of good standing	\$19.00	\$20.00
Cuban Liberation Civil Filing Fee	\$6,548.00	\$6,800.00
Administrative Fee for filling a Civil Action, Suit or Proceeding in a District Court	\$50.00	\$52.00

The increase to the Administrative Fee for filling a Civil Action, Suit or Proceeding in a District Court, impacts the total filing fee collected when a civil action is filed. Thus, the total filing fees that are due when a civil action is filed will increase from \$400.00 to

\$402.00 (the \$350.00 statutory fee plus the \$52.00 miscellaneous administrative fee).

These changes will become effective on **December 1, 2020**.
