In-person and VTC hearings of defendants on-bond, as well as all civil proceedings, will be held as scheduled, subject to any specific instructions provided by the presiding judge.

District Court operations and services to the public within the Clerk's Office and the U.S. Probation Office resumed on Tuesday September 20, 2022. The United States Attorneys' Office, law enforcement agencies and the members of the Bar are on notice that the duty Magistrate Judge remains available on regular duty schedule.
