## NOTICE FROM THE CLERK NO. 07-20

Increase to Transcript Fee Rates; New Transcript Delivery Category

At its September 2007 session, the Judicial Conference approved an increase to original and copy Maximum Transcript Rates effective October 1, 2007 (FY 2008). The new fees are listed below at a per page cost and are effective immediately, that is, November 1, 2007. Transcripts ordered prior to November, 1, 2007, the date of the Court's adoption of the new rates, should be billed at the rates in effect at the time the transcript order was placed with the official court reporter.

The Judicial Conference also approved creation of an additional 14-day category of transcript delivery to fill the gap between ordinary (30-day) and expedited (7-day) delivery times. Until the Administrative Office is able to revise the Transcript Order form (AO 435), users may write in "14-day" or use the expedited (7-day) category to record these transactions. With respect to the CJA 24 for (Authorization and Voucher for Payment of Transcript), attorneys should: check "expedited" and write "14-day" in available space in item 14B (without this notation, "expedited" would be a 7-day transcript).

Hourly Transcript A transcript of proceedings ordered under unusual circumstances to be delivered within two (2) hours.	\$7.25	\$1.20	\$.90
Realtime Transcript A draft unedited transcript produced by a certified realtime reporter as a byproduct of realtime to be delivered electronically during proceedings or immediately following adjournment.	\$3.05	\$1.20
