**TRANSFER OF UNCLAIMED FUNDS TO THE  
U.S. TREASURY PURSUANT TO 28 U.S.C.A. §2042**

Title 28 U.S.C.A. §2042 provides that “[i]n every case in which the right to withdraw money deposited in Court under section 2041 has been adjudicated or is not in dispute and such money has remained so deposited for at least five (5) years unclaimed by the person entitled thereto, such court shall cause such money to be deposited in the Treasury in the name and to the credit of the United States.”

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C.A. §2042, these monies will be transferred to the United States Treasury within sixty (60) days of the date of this Notice, absent a claim to the contrary. An order directing payment to the claimant will be issued upon full proof of entitlement.
