**EXTENSION OF POLICY ON MANDATORY USE OF FACE MASKS
IN THE JOSÉ V. TOLEDO UNITED STATES COURTHOUSE IN OLD SAN JUAN**

Please be advised that all employees and visitors, including but not limited to members of the bar, press and public, will continue to be required to wear a face mask or face covering while in all public areas of the José V. Toledo United States Courthouse in Old San Juan, including courtrooms. This mandatory requirement is consistent with the March 10, 2022, determination of the Facilities Security Committee of the José V. Toledo United States Courthouse building in Old San Juan.
